



Fee Schedule

Consultations

Consultations can be held in person, by telephone, or via internet video conferencing. These can cover any aspect of the business and investment visa process. Travel expenses may apply to in-person consultations.

Fee: \$100.00 per hour

Legitimacy of Funds

If there is an essential piece to gaining an approval on a business and investment visa, it is demonstrating the legitimacy of the funds being invested. There are three key elements: 1) that the funds originate from legitimate sources, 2) that a two year history or explanation of the funds be provided, 3) that the funds be solely those of the investor. Support in this area can be as little as guidance on the required documentation to assistance in developing the documentation.

Fee: \$100.00 to \$500.00

Development of Executive Summary

The Executive Summary provides the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services and the U.S. Department of State with an overview of the investor, the business, the contributions the investor will make to the organization, and the financial history and projections that justify the business and expected growth. Additionally, it must be clear how the investment will generate five new employment opportunities

Fee: \$300.00 to \$1,500.00

Development of Business Plan

A business plan has multiple sections from the overview to the financial documents. Business plans typically come in two formats: The Operational format explaining how the business operates presently and will operate in the future, and the Financial format for the purpose of acquisition of funding. The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services prefers the Operational format. The more complex the organization, the more detailed the business plan. The plan must be constructed in language that is clear, concise, and understandable. Immigration Services officers are not MBA graduates.

Fee: \$2,500.00 to \$10,000.00

Completion of Required Forms

The completion of the required U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services forms is very straight-forward. At the same time, the forms must be completed properly.

Fee: \$300.00

Referral to a Business and Immigration Attorney

It is essential that applicants for a Treaty-Trader or Treaty-Investor visa be represented by an attorney and that the attorney review the submission package. Attorney fees can range from \$300 to \$600 for the review and initial representation but can increase with challenges from the USCIS.

Fee: No Charge

Assembly of the Submission Package

The Submission Package is assembled in an order that makes the review by the attorney and the USCIS as straight-forward as possible.

Fee: \$300.00

Review of Materials and Assistance Following Submission

A thorough review of materials prior to submission, and assistance after submission is available.

Fee: \$100.00 per hour
